## **Help Request!**

In a couple months, San Gabriel voters will be given the opportunity to vote on a school bond measure. Measure SG will fund critical repairs and upgrades at every school in the District, including Gabrielino. Some of the improvements include:

- Provide modern labs, career technical facilities, and equipment so students are prepared for college and in-demand careers like engineering, technology and skilled trades.
- Remove hazardous materials like asbestos and lead pipes from older school sites, where encountered
- Create modern, multi-use classrooms to support hands-on science instruction and learning-by-doing
- Repair older classrooms and school facilities including deteriorating roofs, plumbing, sewer, heating, ventilation, and electrical systems
- Improve student safety and campus security systems including security fencing, security cameras and fire alarms.
