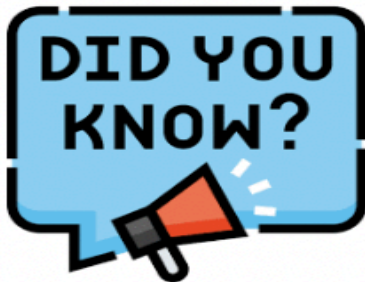




SGTA Roles



Have you ever wondered what all the different roles are within SGTA? Here's a basic description of some of them.

Executive Board:

Executive Board is made up of elected officers; President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary. The term is 2 years. They coordinate day-to-day duties of our Association, direct bargaining activities, and direct grievance activities.

Representatives (Also called Rep Council):

Representatives are elected at each site. Each site is allowed one site rep for every 10 members. The term is 1 year. They are the liaison between site members and the rest of the rep council (which includes the Executive Board). They represent the voice of the membership.

Bargaining Team:

These team members are appointed by the President, with concurrence of the Executive Board. They survey members to determine what should be bargained. They report to Executive Board. They research and strategize the details of the bargaining proposals. They have the authority to reach a tentative agreement with the district, which is then voted on by the membership.

*Site Reps can be part of the bargaining team but they are separate roles. Bargaining team members are not required to be members of Rep Council. Members of Executive Board are not on the bargaining team.
